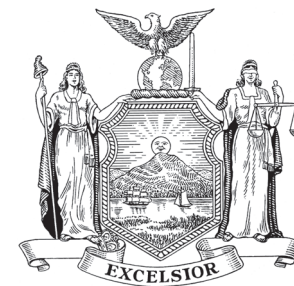




The Assembly *State of New York*
